




About the College

Mar Theophilus Training College, one of the premier Teacher Education Colleges in Kerala is situated in the lush green and scenic Mar Ivanios Vidya Nagar and owes its inception to the prayerful insight of the divine visionary, the late Archbishop Mar Ivanios. The foundation of this great centre of learning was laid by the Archbishop of Trivandrum, His Grace Benedict Mar Gregorios. Under the unfailing and vital guidance of our patron, His Beatitude Moron Mor Baselios Cardinal Cleemis, Major Archbishop Catholicos of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church, the College is now attempting newer heights of excellence. The College is owned and managed by the Major Archdiocese of Trivandrum.

The College derives its name from the Late Bishop Jacob Mar Theophilos of Thiruvalla. It started functioning in July 1956, under the affliation of the then University of Travancore in the premises of Mar Ivanios College Campus. Later shifted to a new campus which is now occupied by Sarvodaya Vidyalaya. In 2001, College was set up in the present campus with futuristic infrastructural facilities in accordance with NCTE norms.

Prof. T.Y. Thampy Haris, a renowned scholar, served as the first Principal of the College. Eminent and distinguished personalities have adorned the post of the principal of the College. Dr. K.Y. Benedict presently heads the College, steering it steadily through changing times. Rev. Fr. Thomas Kayyalakal, the Bursar, caters to the physical and spiritual well-being of the College.

The College offers B.Ed. in six optional subjects. It commenced its first M.Ed. batch in 2005. The implacable standard maintained by the College in the field of research has finally attained fruition with its elevation to the Research Centre under University of Kerala.

The College in its 65th year of nation building is committed to mould teachers who are intellectually honest, academically effluent, technologically equipped and emotionally mature in their words and deeds. 





FAQ's

Q1. Is there any age limit to pursue B.Ed course?

The candidate must be 20 years of age to pursue this course and No upper age limit.

Q2. What are the career options available after M.Ed. course completion?

There are a number of posts with different national bodies like NCERT/NIEPA etc where M.Ed. Degree holders can get better academic positions as a Research Assistant, Assistant Professor and alike.

Q3. How long does a Ph.D. take?

Ph.D programmes last for a minimum of three years. Students are expected to submit a thesis within 12 months of the end of the programme (and preferably within the three year period.)

Q4. How much will Ph.D. cost me?

This depends on where you are from, where and what you want to study and whether or not you qualify for funding like obtaining UGC-NET or JRF.

Q5. What is the pay for Postdoctoral fellow?

Pay varies according to the type of fellowship or grant that you hold. Currently, at the very least it is Rs 24,000 + 30% HRA, per month. If you obtain an independently funded fellowship pay can be much higher.

Q6. What are the work timings for post docs?

There are no fixed timings; as a postdoc you are expected to plan your work. At present, there is no contract for a postdoc, thus terms of reference regarding leave and working hours are not set.

Q7. Is it mandatory to qualify SET to become Higher Secondary Teacher in Kerala?

No, if You have completed M.Ed., then SET is not a mandatory factor to become Higher Secondary Teacher in Kerala.


