
IGAC Meeting held on 1-7-2022



The committee audited the quality initiatives of the past two months. The committee expressed satisfaction about the programmes.


It was decided to conduct media awareness programmes for the B.Ed students. Students also may be given training in Conserving Nature.


IGAC Meeting Held on 1-9-2021



The committee evaluated the activities of the previous months and gave suggestions.


