A BRIEF SUMMARY OF RUSA 2022-2023

The RUSA 2.0 project started in 2019. Dr. Ancy A S is serving as RUSA Coordinator. Central government allotted 2 crore rupees-1crore for new construction,74 lakh for renovation and 26 for purchase. We constructed 4 classrooms with this amount and the construction work is completed. In the renovation part renovation of seminar hall is completed, multipurpose hall work is going on and we have to start skill lab after completion of the multi-purpose hall. After the completion of these two works, construction and renovation we have to purchase things which are useful for these buildings.

CRITERIA 1: CURRICULAR ASPECTS

Institution has a regular in-house practice of planning and revising curriculum in an adequate manner. The institution has a curriculum committee which organized 3 meetings with the office bearers in the 2022-23 academic year by upholding the PLOs and CLOs. The decisions taken in the meeting were implemented in a meticulous manner. Student induction programme was conducted in the year 2022-23 with the support of external experts, alumni member and by the members of the staff. The teachers attended orientation programmes in both online and offline mode. The institution also has the mechanism to obtain structured feedback on the curriculum – semester wise from various stakeholders.

CRITERIA 2: TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION

It is ensured that the students explore an exciting academic journey. The diverse needs of the students are identified, and the teaching-learning is fashioned accordingly to suit the needs of the individual learner. Teaching-learning process carried out in the institution is not mere information sharing by teachers and reproduction of shared information by students in the exams. The teachers make students connect with what is taught at the cognitive and affective levels. The teachers develop teaching plans for the courses they teach. The teaching plan is designed with a focus on the unit-wise learning outcomes. Every teaching plan

includes e-resources to be used, assignments to be given, collaborative tasks to be assigned, constructivist methods to be employed, enrichment content to be shared, discussions to be conducted, and special lectures to be arranged. Experiential and participatory strategies are used to make the learners active and engaged. Techno centric classrooms are the key element in the institution. The students are given rigorous training in teaching skills and lesson plan preparation. Students are taken to induction programmes at various schools prior to teaching practice. This familiarizes them with the different kinds of school setups. Besides this Micro teaching sessions and video recording of the classes are done at class level. Furthermore, criticism classes are arranged at college level with the support of the model school attached to the college.

CRITERIA 3: RESEARCH AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

Our college students are involved in research activities and outreach activities. We have a research centre with 51 research scholars. We have been publishing our research journal since 2004. We have 18 research guides in our approved research centre of University of Kerala. We are offering service as resource persons in HRDCs. We are offering training to parents as extension activities. We visited and offered service to Tribal school and train the parents in the school. We conducted invited talks for public and some of the topics are "Raise Your Vibrations," "Secularism and Democracy in India," and "Future Skills,". We conduct twinning program every year with a special school. Overall, these efforts contribute positively to both community welfare and educational enrichment. Our faculty members have demonstrated remarkable scholarly achievements including seven publications in UGC CARE journals, five chapters to esteemed academic books, and receiving three prestigious awards in recognition of their outstanding contributions to public welfare and academic community.

A robust infrastructure forms the foundation for effective and enriched learning environment. Modern classrooms, equipped with advanced technology, catalyse dynamic teaching methodologies. Lecture halls, enhanced with state-of-the-art

The extensive library with diverse pedagogical resources, becomes a scholarly haven, supporting comprehensive research and lesson planning. Beyond physical spaces, a virtual learning ecosystem seamlessly integrates online resources, fostering collaborative learning. This meticulously designed infrastructure empowers aspiring educators, cultivating an atmosphere where knowledge seamlessly transcends, and innovative teaching practices thrive.
